## **Surgery Update**

The old pharmacy is being developed into two new clinical rooms and more storage space. Conversion work starts on Feb 18th with completion due in April. The refurbishment of the upstairs room into a total triage hub is already nearly complete

Recruitment of new staff is proceeding with the planned appointment of a Practice Manager, Reception Lead, Apprentices, and GP Assistants all in the pipeline.

The new appointment system is now in place and working well. Sixty people attended the public meeting to explain the new system and there was much positive discussion and useful feedback. Patients requiring an appointment can now go to the surgery website and complete a simple questionnaire. This is read and discussed by the triage team and appropriate action taken. Patients who do not have the capability to go online can phone the surgery and the reception team will fill out the form on their behalf. The new system means there is no mad rush at 8.00am and the system is fairer. Overall the experience has been positive for both patients and staff.
